#### Minutes of the September 13, 2021 Meeting

Gamma Eta Chapter held its first meeting of the 2021 school year on Monday, September 13, 2021, at 5:30 p.m. at First Baptist Church, Crosbyton. In attendance were the following members: Donna Anderson, KDee Anderson, Debbi Ball, Terri Egerton, Tiffany Harkins, Pat Hightower, Brenda Karr, Stephanie Martinez, Sharon McDougle, Merla Watson, and Jean Williams. Janie Wigley joined by ZOOM. Stephanie had two guests: Payton Swieczkowski and Candace Zarate.

President Terri Egerton addressed the group with a few important announcements. Minutes from the April 12, 2021 in the Gamma Eta News were approved as printed. Treasurer Sharon McDougle stated that the 2021-2022 Budget was in the Gamma Eta News. The July 1, 2021 balance was \$2,462.21. The only expense has been the purchase of a President's Pin for Terri.

The "Brags for Grants" bucket was passed around and brags were heard from Pat that she has received her grant again; Debbi stated that Elisha had a negative Covid test; Terri reported that everyone was finally well in her household; Brenda bragged on the good work of the Achievement Committee on submitting Janie's name for the 2021 TSO Achievement Award; and Donna shared that school had started for her grandchildren at school and in her home as well.

ASTEF has asked for 1 themed basket and 1 small item to be auctioned off as a fundraiser at Area Workshop. Other items discussed were table decorations and door prizes.

Terri noted that Hostess Groups had been reworked and the changes will be in the 2021-2022 Gamma Eta Yearbook.

Business meeting was adjourned and members played games and had a time of fellowship.
